AWARDS and SCORING: Each participant will receive points in each race and extra points will be given to the top three finishing times in each category. Points will be awarded for best classic technique, best skate technique and best team spirit. Medals will be awarded to the top three boys and the top three girls of each age group in the Individual Classic and the Heat Sprint events. Top two girls and boys in each category of the Double Cross will receive medals. There are no awards or scoring for fun games (if applicable).

Aggregate trophies will be awarded to the top three schools that have accumulated the most points combined from all four race events (individual classic beginner and experienced, relay and double cross). Top out of town team will receive a gold pan award.

BEGINNER CATEGORY VS. EXPERIENCED CATEGORY

<u>Beginner</u> – register in the beginner category if you have never cross country skied, tried x-country skiing through the ski school program or only ski twice per year on average. <u>Experienced</u> – you are on a ski race team, enrolled in the Jackrabbit Program, ski in a program at school multiple times through the year for a couple of years (more than the three visits to Hallis with the Ski School Program this year) or want more challenge!
