

CSTC Lodge Decorating Policy

This policy is intended to prevent damage to the lodge and its fixtures.

Nails, tacks, other types of tape, screws, or staples must not be used to fasten decorations to the walls, doors, curtains, glass or any other part of the facility.

Painters tape (green) is the only acceptable fastening material to be used on walls, ceiling, lighting and windows.

Emergency exits and service doors must not be blocked with any decorations, equipment, or chairs.

Candles are prohibited; no open flame inside the lodge or on the outer decks except for contained in the fireplace or barbeques. Fires can only be established outside the lodge in the fire pit provided.

Pictures may be removed for decorating purposes provided they are stored or secured safely and returned to their original position. **EXCEPTIONS**: the wooden skis above the fireplace, the skates and snow shoes on the wall and the bulletin boards are not to be removed. Pictures removed from the wall will be stored in the provided storage box to prevent wear and damage from handling.

The Cariboo Ski Touring Club will not provide a ladder for decorating purposes.
